This funding will be used to

- Increase QCE/QCIA to 98%
- Increase A- C attainment in English, Mathematics and Science to 85% across Year 7 - 10.
- Increase A – C attainment for whole school across all KLAs to 90%.

Our initiatives include

- Teaching 21st Century Fluencies across all faculties.
- Supporting a master teacher to implement a whole school literacy plan.
- Building teacher capacity through the introduction of peer coaching to engage all teachers in professional dialogue.
- Academic coaching for all students led by the Dean - Senior Secondary and Dean - Junior Secondary.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employing additional teachers and teacher aides to support teaching of literacy and numeracy.	\$62,000
• Providing resources to support teaching 21 ST Century Fluencies.	\$33,000
• Professional Development to support 21 ST Century Fluencies in core areas.	\$20,000
• Providing resources to support master teacher in implementing whole school literacy plan.	\$7,500
• Providing release time for teachers to engage in coaching.	\$7,500
• Providing professional development for teachers on delivering extension activities for high performing students.	\$30,000
• Teaching resources	\$6,130
